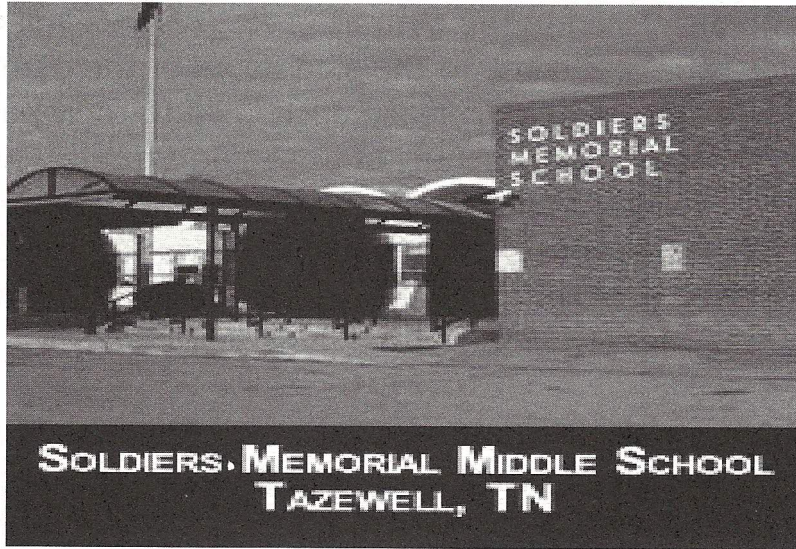

Procedures for Early and Late Pick-ups

1. Early pick-ups will be dismissed to the gym at 2:45. Parents will enter the property off of Cedar Lane and come to the side doors of the gymnasium. Teachers will be at the side doors to release each child to their parent. Parents will exit off the front of the school onto Legion Street. Early pick-ups will remain in the gymnasium until second call is announced at approximately 3:10. At this time, the remaining students who have not been picked up will be taken to the cafeteria and they will become late pick-ups. Between 2:45 and 3:10, students must be picked up at the gym.
2. Late pick-ups will be dismissed to the cafeteria at 3:10. Parents will enter school property off of Fulkerson Street and come to the front entrance. Parents must park at the front and come to the cafeteria to pick up their child. Students are not allowed to exit the building unless picked up by a parent.

Report Cards

The grading system set by the Claiborne County Board of Education and used by this school is as follows:

- A 93 -100
- B 85 - 92
- C 75 - 84
- D 70 - 74
- F Any grade below 70
- S Satisfactory Participation (Physical Education)

Report cards are issued every six (6) weeks and must be signed by the parents or legal guardian and returned. Three weeks into each grading period a progress report will be sent home also requiring parent signature. Grades received will represent the teachers' evaluations of the progress made by the student. The evaluations will emphasize not only scholastic achievement, but also worthwhile habits, attitudes, and skills necessary for the full development of the child.

A planned parent-teacher conference can be scheduled at the request of the parent or teacher.

There will be a parent-teacher conference each six weeks the day after the report card is sent home.

Withdrawal From School Policy

Students are to return all books assigned to them; which includes all textbooks, and/or workbooks, library books, etc. Students are to return all equipment issued to them (sports uniforms, etc.) Students who cannot return these items must pay for them. Students are to pay any money owed to S.M.M.S. (lunch charges, unreturned library books, picture money, etc.) Students are to enroll at another school as soon as possible. The new school will request the records of that student. The records will be released if that student has paid all debts and returned all school property. Parents are to complete a withdrawal form stating where the student will be enrolling.

Discipline

Our policy at S.M.M.S. is to treat every child fairly and as an individual. Students are expected to behave and follow school rules. Misbehavior will not be tolerated and students will receive consequences based on the severity of their offences, which may include suspension, according to Claiborne County Board of Education Discipline Policy.
